Procedures followed in the decision making process including channels of supervision and accountability
--

The proposals received by the sub-divisions and division in the matter of execution/repairs of water supply and sanitary works are processed and examined by the Chairman/Chief Engineer in terms of the provisions of the BWSSB Act/the instructions of the Government and placed before the Board for approval. The Board is met normally once in a month. In matters of exigency, it can meet frequently.

The Chairman/Chief Engineer/CAOS/CAO/FA is required to prepare the Agenda of the meeting. After approval of the proposal by the Board, the Chairman can implement the decision, if such decisions are within the powers of the Board in such reasonable times as may be required. If the decision requires the approval of the Government, the Chairman will seek the approval accordingly. The Secretary to Government Urban Development Department is vested with the supervisory powers and these officers can suspend/set aside the decision if found to be contrary to the provisions of the BWSSB Act.
