For and on behalf of the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board, **SHORT TERM ITEMWAR TENDER** is invited through e-procurement process with tender procedure in line with Rule 28 of the KTPP Act by the Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitary Division (North West-2), 1st floor, Suvarna Bhavan, Margosa Road, 18th cross Malleshwaram, Bangalore-560055 for the following work from registered Agencies of appropriate class as indicated against each work of **BWSSB/KUWSDB/KPWD**, etc. Who are having adequate financial resources, past experience in similar nature of work possessing valid GST registration. The Board keeps the right of acceptance or rejection of any tender without assigning any reasons.

The Tenderers are required to pay the **Earnest Money Deposit only through e-procurement portal** only using any of the four modes.

1. (1)Credit Card (Online Payment) (2) Direct Debit Using Internet Banking (Online Payment) (3) Remittance at the Bank Counter - Challan (Offline Payment) (4) NEFT (Offline payment). The details regarding their capability to undertake the tender (as detailed in ITT Clause 4) and the price tender shall be uploaded in the website. Technical details will be opened on the date and time mentioned in ITT clause 5 and evaluated. The price tender of the Tenderer, who is found to be qualified to execute the tendered works, will be opened on the date notified later. The Tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria specified in Clause 3 of the Instructions to Tenderers to qualify for award of the contract.
2. Tender documents may be downloaded from www.eproc.karnataka.gov.in website only. Interested tenderers may obtain further information at the same address.
3. Additional information related to e-procurement process can be obtained through the above mentioned website or contact e-procurement helpdesk No.080-2550 1216 / 2550 1227. The electronic tender comprising Technical and Financial bids will be operated as Single stage Tender system.
4. Bidders can access tender documents from www.eproc.karnataka.gov.in website only and upload the required details; those are mentioned in different sections in the bid document in to electronic tender on the website. Scanned documents those are required to be furnished as per Section 2, 3 & 4 of the bid document shall be submitted through e-procurement.
5. The Tender processing fee once paid will not be refunded.

The Last date and time for Receipt of tenders will be on 17/06/2020 upto 16:00Hrs and the date of opening of tender will be on 19/06/2020 after 15:00 Hrs.

The Eligibility criterion for the above works allotted for General category is as follows:


- Contractors should have registration in BWSSB or KPWD/KUWSDB, etc Those who does not have BWSSB registration can also participate in the tender provided they should get registered in the Board in case the tender is awarded before the issue of Work Order.
- Form of tender is mandatory to upload in e-procurement portal.
- Assessed available tender capacity $= (A*N*2.5-B)$ should be greater than amount put to tender.
- The tenderer should have in the last 5 years period achieved in at least two financial years an average annual financial turnover of rupees not less than the estimated cost. (Profit and loss account, Balance sheet certified/Audited by chartered accountant).
- The tenderer should have satisfactorily completed one similar work to an extent of 50% of the cost of the work.
- The successful bidder would be required to give performance bank guarantee of 5% of the contract amount plus additional security for unbalanced bid amount from a Nationalized / Scheduled India Bank, with jurisdiction at Bangalore as specified, towards guarantee for completion of work within the stipulated period.

Eligibility criterion for the above works allotted SC/ST category

- Contractors should have registration in BWSSB or KPWD/KUWSDB, etc Those who does not have BWSSB registration can also participate in the tender provided they should get registered in the Board in case the tender is awarded before the issue of Work Order.
- Form of tender is mandatory to upload in e-procurement portal.
- Assessed available tender capacity $= (A*N*5-B)$ should be greater than amount put to tender.
- Caste certificate should be uploaded in the e-procurement portal issued from the concerned Authority for authentication at the time of bidding.

- Security Deposit for an amount equivalent to 5% of the contract price shall be deducted in every running bill. However, in case of First and final bill the entire security deposit will be deducted from the bill.
 - If in two attempts of tender bidding process, Bidders belonging to Scheduled castes and Scheduled Tribes participate is not Qualified, under this rule, then these works shall be tendered as open category wherein all eligible bidders of General or Scheduled castes or Schedules tribes category can participate.
 - The Tenderer Should have a in the last 5 years period achieved in atleast one financial years an average turnover of not less than estimated cost of the respective works (Profit & loss account, Balance sheet certified/ Audited by chartered accountant).
 - The Tenderer should have satisfactorily completed one similar work to an extent of 25% of the cost of the respective works.
 - If Contractor is the firm, then all the partners or members of the firm shall belong to the Schedule casters or Schedule Tribes as the case may be.
 - The contractor belonging to the Schedule Castes of Schedule Tribes shall be domicile of the state of Karnataka for more than 10 Years.
6. The tender is based on Single Cover System
Contractors should have registration in BWSSB or KPWD/KUWSDB, etc as per KTPP act. Those who does not have BWSSB registration can also participate in the tender provided they should get registered in the Board in case the tender is awarded before the issue of Work Order.
7. The Form of tender as per KW-1 should be uploaded during bidding for the tender
8. The third party inspection will be carried for the work and the third party will be nominated by BWSSB.
9. Applications / requisitions from joint venture Firms are not acceptable.
10. Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board (BWSSB) reserve the right to cancel or annul the entire or part of this process of invitation at any time without assigning any reason.
11. For any additional information regarding the above tender, the firms who are interested to quote, may contact office of the undersigned at the office address given below on all working days during office hours (10:30 hours to 17:00 hours).
12. List of documents to support qualification of bidder is to be uploaded to the e-procurement website www.eproc.karnataka.gov.in
13. All other conditions put forth as per KW-1 of KTPP act shall be followed read with amendments vide G.O No.FD4PCL 2008 Bangalore Dt:14.10.2008
14. Other details can be seen in the tender documents
15. Road cutting machine should be used mandatorily for cutting the approved width of road while executing the work as per circular No.BWSSB/CH/CAO-s/CHI/138/19-20 Dt:04.09.2019.
16. Within 20 Days of the receipt of the letter of acceptance, the successful tenderer shall deliver to the employer a Security deposit in any of the forms given below. **For an amount equivalent to 5% of the contract price plus additional security for unbalanced tenders in accordance with clause 24.3 of ITT & clause 44 of the conditions of contract for all works** from a Nationalized / Scheduled Indian Bank, with jurisdiction at Bangalore as specified.
