For and on behalf of the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board, Short term **ITEMWAR TENDER** is invited through e-procurement process with tender procedure in the with Rule 28 of the KTCP Act by the Executive Engineer, Water Supply and Sanitary Division (North East) 18th Cross, Malleshwaram, Bangalore-56011 for the following work from registered Agencies of appropriate class as indicated against each work of **BWSSB/KUWSDB/KPWD**, etc. Who are having adequate financial resources, past experience in similar nature of work possessing valid VAT registration. The Board keeps the right of acceptance or rejection of any tender without assigning any reasons.

The Tenderers are required to pay the Earnest Money Deposit only through e-procurement portal only using any of the four modes.

- (1)Credit Card (Online Payment) 2) Direct Debit Using Internet Banking (Online Payment) 3) Remittance at the Bank Counter – Challan (Offline Paymnet) (4) NEFT (Offline Payment). The details regarding their capability to undertake the tender (as detailed in ITT Clause 4)and the tender shall be uploaded in the website. Tenders will be opened on the date and time mentioned in ITT clause 5 and evaluated. The Tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria specified in Clause 3 of the Instructions to Tenderers to qualify for award of the contract.

documents those are required to be furnished as per Section 2, 3 & 4 of the bid document shall be submitted through e-procurement.

- The Tender processing fee once paid will not be refunded.

The Eligibility criterion for the above works is as follows:

- The tender is based on Two Cover System
- Contractors should have Civil Contractor registration in BWSSB or KPWD/KUWSDB etc., Those who does not have BWSSB registration can also participate in the tender provided they should get registered in Board in case the tender is awarded before the issue of Work Order.
- The Tenderer should have in the last 5 years period achieved in at least two financial years an average annual financial turnover of rupees not less than the estimated cost under this contract i.e **Rs.90.18 Lakhs.** (profit & loss account balance sheet certified audit by chartered accountant)
- The tenderer should have satisfactorily completed one similar work to an extent of 50% of the cost of the work, i.e **Rs.45.09 Lakhs.**
- Liquid assets and or availability of credit facilities usually 30% of the amount of contract i.e **Rs.27.05 Lakhs.** Laksh as per the format of KTTP act.
- The tenderer should have executed in any one year the following minimum quantities of works usually 60% of the annual requirement i.e
(A) 1 mt depth & above RCC man holes 195 Nos (160+25+10) at 60% of annual requirement i.e., 1 mtr depth and above - 117 Nos of RCC man holes.
- Assessed Available Tender Capacity (A*N*2.5-B).
- Form of tender is mandatory to upload in e-procurement portal.
- The rates quoted in the tender offer shall be by considering the benefits of concession rate of Central Sales Tax (for all interstate procurement of materials

only) as per section * (1) of the CST Act, 1956. Necessary Form 'C' will be issued by Board. After implementation of GST if this clause is removed then bidder consider to the latest amendment.

- Refer Annexure (A) enclosed along for jurisdiction of the courts and safety measures to be taken will executing in the work as per letter No.BWSSB/EIC/CE(P)/0027/2016-17 Dt:10.01.2017 and further here by informed to include the same in the contract agreement.
- The rates quoted should be inclusive of Third party inspection charges and applicable taxes that will be recovered from the bills. Third party will be nominated by BWSSB.
- The successful bidder would be required to give performance bank **guarantee of 5%** of the contract amount plus additional security for unbalanced bid amount from a nationalized / Scheduled Indian Bank, with jurisdiction at Bangalore as specified, towards guarantee for completion of work within the stipulated period.
- Applications / requisitions from joint venture Firms are not acceptable.
- Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board (BWSSB) reserve the right to cancel or annual the entire or part of this process of invitation at any time without assigning any reason.
- For any additional information regarding the above tender, the firms who are interested to quote, may contact office of the undersigned at the office address given below on all working days during office hours (10:30 hours to 17:00 hours).
- List of documents to support qualification of bidder is to be uploaded to the e-procurement website www.eproc.karnataka.gov.in
- Bidders shall submit offers that comply with the requirements of the bid documents, including the basic technical design as indicated in the drawing and specifications. Alternatives will not be considered. The attention of the bidders is drawn to clause 22 regarding the rejection of the bids, which are not substantially responsive to the requirement of the bid document.
