The Chief Engineer, (Kaveri), Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board invites tenders from eligible tenderers, for **Procurement, Erection and Commissioning of two new 8MVA, 66KV/6.6KV Power Transformers as a spare at any three locations(T.K. Halli, Harohalli & Tataguni)**. Two Cover Tender procedures as per Rule 28 of the KTPP Act viz., (1) **Technical Proposal** (2) **Price Proposal**. Both the documents should be uploaded in the e-procurement portal. **Manual bids will not be accepted.**

1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION.

Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board is responsible for supplying drinking water to Bangalore city. Under Cauvery Water Supply Scheme (CWSS) raw water is abstracted from Cauvery River, treated at Thorekadanahalli and is pumped to Bangalore city in three stages, T.K.Halli, Harohalli and Tataguni locations.

Under CWSS Stage 2 project, Two 8 MVA Power Transformers were installed in 1981 and during the execution of CWSS Stage 3 project one additional 8 MVA Power Transformer was installed with facility to parallel all the three transformers in 1993. The above facility is catering to the load of both stages 2 & stage 3 pumping stations. The existing Power Transformers are serviced more than 40 Years and 29 years old,also as Power Transformer with secondary voltage 6.6 kV is difficult to get within short time,BWSSB proposes to Procure two new 8 MVA, 66KV/6.6KV Power Transformers as a spare at any three locations (T.K.Halli, Harohalli & Tataguni). The work involves supply, erection, testing and commissioning of two new 8 MVA Power Transformers on existing Transformer bay.

2. SCOPE OF WORK:

The work involves supply, erection, testing and commissioning of two new 8 MVA Power Transformers on existing Transformer bay.

The salient features of the Scope include, but not limited to, the following:

- a) Overall Project Management, Coordination.
 - b) Preparation of design drawing of Power Transformer as per standard drawing / technical specifications as per bill of materials.
 - c) All statutory clearance, wherever required shall be arranged by the Contractor, CEIG and Electrical Inspectorate. BWSSB shall extend all required support in this regard.
 - d) Design, engineering, manufacture, factory testing, supply on FOR Destination to site basis, transportation, insurance, unloading, storing, handling and moving into the final position, erection, installation, testing, commissioning and putting the equipment into successful operation at existing Substation..
3. The interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Office of The Chief Engineer, (Kaveri), BWSSB.

Issues on which clarifications are sought by the Prospective Bidders shall be submitted in writing to the Chief Engineer, (Kaveri), Bangalore on or before the date and time as mentioned in the e-Procurement platform. Letters seeking clarifications received subsequent to this date will not be entertained. Interested Bidders need to mention their firm credentials along with the queries.

4. The Tenderers shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the amount as shown in column 4 of the Table of IFT for this Work. The Tenderers are required to pay the Earnest Money Deposit through e-procurement portal only using any of the four modes.
- a) Credit Card (Online Payment)
 - b) Direct Debit Using Internet Banking (Online Payment)
 - c) Remittance at the Bank Counter - Challan (Offline Payment)
 - d) NEFT (Offline payment).
5. Bids shall be submitted in two parts viz., (1) **Technical Proposal** (2) **Price Proposal**. Both the documents should be uploaded in the e-procurement portal. **Manual bids will not be accepted.**

The following documents have to be submitted in the **Technical Proposal**.

- I. Performance certificate for supply, erection, testing & commissioning of 8 MVA Power Transformer.
- II. Power of Attorney in favor of all the persons signing the documents,

- III. Audited financial statements,
- IV. Works on hand details,
- V. Valid Super Grade Electrical License issued by GOK as on the date of Bid Submission.
- VI. Certificate of Incorporation of all the participating companies in case of registered companies / Partnership deed in case of Partnership Firm.
- VII. GST registration and PAN Card in case of proprietorship Firm.
- VIII. No Deviation Certificate.
- IX. Letter of Undertaking.
- X. Type Test certificates.
- XI. Self-declaration regarding Litigation w.r.t KPTCL contracts over the last five years (refer clause 10.0).
- XII. Self-declaration for 'not being disqualified regarding non-performance in any of the Government utilities in the past five years'.
- XIII. An undertaking to source the supply of equipment/material from KPTCL approved Vendors only as per the revised QR for Vendor registration, available in the KPTCL website i.e., www.kptcl.com, Link Tendering & Procurement.

These qualifying documents are to be uploaded to the respective files only, IF ANY OF DOCUMENTS ARE UPLOADED TO THE FILE OTHER THAN THE SPECIFIED FILES, SUCH DOCUMENTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR EVALUATION. If any of the documents are not applicable to a particular Bidder, then such Bidders have to upload a document stating "Not Applicable". The other documents if any which needs to be uploaded by the Bidder for which no specific files have been created to substantiate or to meet the requirements of the bids, such additional documents may be uploaded in the folder named as "additional documents" in the e-Procurement portal.

No hard copy/copies of additional documents other than those already uploaded will be entertained

Litigation: The bidder should provide detailed information on any litigation or arbitration arising out of contracts completed or under execution by it over the last five years with KPTCL. A history of awards involving litigations against the bidder or any party or JV may result in rejection of bid.

6. QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS (QR):

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

Bidder shall be financially sound and shall submit audited financial reports for last five years preceding the date of bid submission. Bidder shall have adequate knowledge of Sub-Stations design procedures including quality control and shall have infrastructure and erection facilities and capacity to execute the works.

7. GENERAL WORK EXPERIENCE:

- a) The tenderer in its name should have valid “**Super grade Electrical License**” issued by Chief Electrical Inspectorate, Govt of Karnataka.
- b) The Tenderer as a prime contractor should have satisfactorily completed during the last five years i.e., **2016-17 to 2020-21** at least one similar work of procurement, erection, and commissioning of two new 8 MVA, 66kV/6.6 kV Power Transformers to an extent of 50% of the cost of the work value not less than **Rs.120.92 Lakhs**.
- c) Executed in any one year, the following minimum quantities of work (Usually 80% of the peak annual rate of construction) procurement, erection and commissioning of **2 Nos of 5 MVA Power Transformers** in last 5 years in one or more contract.

8. FINANCIAL CAPABILITIES:

- a) To qualify for award of this contract, each tenderer in its name should have in the last five years i.e., **2016-17 to 2020-21** achieved in at least two financial years a minimum financial turnover (in all classes of engineering construction works) of **Rs.483.70 Lakhs**.
- b) Liquid assets and / or availability of credit facilities of not less than **Rs.60.46 Lakhs** for the above work (Credit Lines/letter of credit / certificates from Nationalized / Scheduled banks in India for meeting the fund requirement etc.,)
- c) Assessed available tender capacity – $(A \times N \times 1.5 - B)$ Should not be less than amount put to tender i.e. **Rs.2,41,85,493/-**

Where A = Maximum value of Electrical engineering works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to 2020-21 price level) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which tenders are invited.

B = Value, at 2020-21 price level, of existing commitments and on-going works to be completed during the next 12 months (period of completion of the works for which Tenders are invited).

Note: The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Employer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent.

Note: Following factors shall be considered to bring the price level to 2020-21.

In the event of the Bidder failing to furnish the financial turnover and the financial commitments along with the offer or furnishes the incorrect information, the offers of such Bidders will be rejected.

9. EQUIPMENT CAPACITY:

Each tenderer should further demonstrate:

a) Availability by owning 100% (50% by owning plus 50% by hiring) of the required/specified key and critical equipment for this work, the relevant documents (Commitment agreements etc.) for availability for this work shall be furnished. Some of the equipment are:

i.	Mobile Crane 12 Ton	-	01 No.
ii.	Welding Generator	-	01 No.

10. OTHER CONDITIONS:

- a) Form of tender as per KW-4 of KTPP act to be uploaded by the participated tenderer which is mandatory.
- b) EMD amount to be paid as prescribed for the said tender.

11. GENERAL:

- a) Notwithstanding the above, if it is found that the performance vis – a - vis works awarded to the Bidder by KPTCL is either behind schedule or not satisfactory, BWSSB will be at liberty to disqualify the Bidder and reject its Bid at the time of techno-commercial evaluation.
- b) If the information furnished by the Bidder / Bidders found to be false at any stage of tendering / execution, then the BWSSB, at its discretion may take action against such Bidder / Bidders. If false information is found at the Tendering stage BWSSB may disqualify the offer of such Bidder, Black list the Firm etc., and if false information is found at execution stage then BWSSB may cancel the works awarded, forfeit the Bank Guarantee furnished against the performance of the contract, Black list the Firm.

12. PUBLIC SECTOR COMPANIES:

Public Owned Enterprises domiciled in the Employer / Lessee Country may be eligible to qualify if, in addition to meeting all the above requirements, and also:

- a) Are commercially oriented Legal Entities distinct from the Employer/Lessee, and are not a Government Department.
 - b) Are financially autonomous, as demonstrated by requirements in their constitutions to provide separate audited accounts and return on Capital, powers to raise loans and obtain Revenues through the sale of Goods or services and
 - c) Are Managerially autonomous.
- PSU's shall note that No preference / advantage of whatever nature will be given in evaluation / comparison of Bids and in Award of Contract.

13. COMMISSIONING PERIOD IS 12 (TWELVE MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF LETTER OF AWARD / LETTER OF INTENT (AS APPLICABLE) INCLUDING MONSOON PERIOD.

Before Bidding for the above Works of the Sub-Station, the Bidder shall fully familiarize himself with the Site conditions and General arrangements, etc. Though BWSSB shall endeavor to provide the information, it shall not be binding for BWSSB to provide the same. The Bidders are advised to visit the Sub-Station Site and acquaint themselves with the site. The Bidders shall be fully responsible for providing all equipment, materials, system and services specified in their scope or otherwise which are required to complete the construction and successful commissioning of the Transformers in all respects. Non-familiarity with the site conditions will not be considered for extra claims and for not carrying out the work in strict conformity with Drawings and Specifications.

Notwithstanding anything stated above or elsewhere in the Tender specifications, BWSSB reserves right to assess the Capability / suitability of the Bidder to perform the overall contract should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of BWSSB.

BWSSB reserves its right to vary or modify any of the tender condition for reasons to be recorded, in case it becomes necessary.
