**DRAFT NOTIFICATION**

No. BWSSB /C/CAO-S/ 580 /2021-22 Dt: 14.06.2021

The draft of the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage (Registration of Agencies for cleaning of manholes and Sewage Treatment Plants) Regulations, 2021 which the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 84 and 88 of the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Act, 1964 (Karnataka Act 36 of 1964) with the previous approval of the State Government is hereby published as required by sub- Section (2) of Section 88 of the said Act, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after thirty days from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received by the Board from any person with respect to the said draft before the expiry of the period specified above will be considered by the Board. Objections and suggestions may be addressed to the Chairman, the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board, Bangalore-560009.

**Draft Regulation**

**1. Title and commencement, application.-**

- (1) These Regulations may be called the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage (Registration of Agencies for cleaning of manholes and Sewage Treatment Plants) Regulation, 2021.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Definitions:- (1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,-**

- (a) "Act" means the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Act, 1964 (Karnataka Act 36 of 1964);
- (b) "Board" means the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board constituted under the Act;

- (c) "Drain, manholes and Sewage Treatment Plants" mean which are within the premises of private person to whom these regulations shall apply and used by such person for collection and treatment of sewage before discharging the same to Board sewage network;
  - (d) "Form" means form appended to these regulations;
  - (e) "Private drainage system" includes facilities provided under sub-section (1) of section 66, having private drain, manhole or Sewage treatment plant in his premises;
  - (f) "Section" means section of Act;
  - (g) "Cleaning Agencies" means any person or body corporate or any service provider registered with the Board under these regulations engaged in providing service to the public for effective cleaning of private drains, manholes and Sewage Treatment Plants with standard operating procedures and with the conditions of applicable laws for time being in force, in this connection;
  - (h) "Registering Authority" means the Board;
  - (i) "Registration Officer" means the officer appointed by the Board for registration of the agencies under these regulations; and
  - (j) "Trained or Certified staff" means any person employed by the registered agency, in connection with cleaning of drain, manholes and Sewage Treatment Plants, having minimum training given by any Government agency or any resource person utilised by the Board to train for maintenance of the standard prescribed and taking precautions and knowledge about the law prevailing in this connection.
- (2) Other words and expressions used but not defined herein shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

**3. Obligation to undertake periodical cleaning through Registered agency.-** Every owner or manager of private drainage system shall undertake the cleaning of the manhole and Sewage Treatment Plants in his premises in every quarter, through Registered cleaning agency.

**4. Obligations of the cleaning agency.-** (1) Any cleaning agency which intends to seek registration under these regulations shall apply in Form, to the Concerned Executive

Engineer with a fee of rupees five hundred. The agency shall possess trade licence issued by the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagarapalike and shall register with such trade under all the applicable Labour and Commercial Establishment laws for time being in force.

(2) The registration shall be valid for two years from date of registration and the agency shall renew its registration by paying a renewal fee of rupees five hundred. Subject to such conditions as may be imposed by the Board.

(3) The Registered agency under these regulations shall abide by the provisions of the Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013 (Central Act 25 of 2013) and also abide by all the Labour Laws for time being in force and regulations made there under.

(4) The Registered agency under these regulations shall provide all adequate safety measures and devices as per the standard of operating procedure of cleaning manholes and Sewage Treatment Plants prescribed by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India. The registered agencies shall recruit the trained or certified manpower in connection with the cleaning of private drain, manholes and Sewage Treatment Plants as per the standard prescribed by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India, trained in any of the Government Agencies and certified by the Board.


(5) The Registered agency shall be wholly responsible for compliance of the provisions of the Act, rules and regulations made under the Act and the conditions of registration and guidelines issued under these regulations during the course of carrying out the work authorized under these regulations.

**5. Powers of the Board.-** (1) The Registration of any the agency shall be subject to fulfillment of the conditions specified under the Act and subject to the conditions specified in these regulation or guidelines issued. The decision of the Board in this connection regarding the suitability of agency for registration shall be final and shall not be appealed in any Civil or Criminal court.

(2) The Board is empowered to prescribe the conditions for registration of an agency and to issue guidelines from time to time for effective implementation of the object these regulations.

- (3) The Board, from time to time, shall organize orientation programmes for rendering effective training to the manpower employed by the Registered agencies, by utilizing the resourceful persons for effective implementation of these regulations.
6. **Breach of the provisions of these regulations.**- Any registered agency which breaches the provisions of these regulations, shall be punishable with fine which may extent to five thousand rupees and in case of continuing breach with an additional fine which may extend to five hundred rupees for every day during which the breach continues, after receipt of a notice from the Board.
7. **Penalty for breach of Regulation 3.**- Any owner or manager of private drain system who violates the provisions of these regulation shall be liable for a fine which may extend to Rs. 5,000/- and incase of continuing violation with an additional fine which may extend to rupees five hundred for every subsequent day of violation.
